

JAIL DILEMMA ON SEX-CHANGE PROSTITUTE

Prison authorities will have to decide to which prison they will send a prostitute who had a sex-change operation 18 years ago. Gloria Greaves, who looks and behaves like a woman but in law is a man, was jailed for 18 months yesterday for living off immoral earnings—a charge applicable only to men. She was also fined £10,000.

Inner London Crown Court was told that Greaves, 50, who was born Thomas Robinson, whipped and caned clients at her house in Warwick Way, Westminster. "Over the past week, we have had a parade of filth and degradation," said the judge, Mr Recorder Roydon Thomas.

Police found a dungeon with stocks, whips and other instruments of "hard correction" when they raided Greaves's three houses. Another woman, "an expert on sadistic sex," was jailed for six months for running a disorderly house and Greaves's disabled husband was jailed for a year for living off the earnings of prostitution.
