Lady Campbell, 26, whose sex-change operation eight years ago was exclusively revealed in the Sunday People, said she lost 20 lb. while they were apart.

The slim, 7-st. blonde, back at the 28-year-old peer's New York flat on fashionable Park Avenue, said: "Living apart caused both of us a lot of anguish."

"Colin phoned me at my parents' home in Jamaica every day until I caught the plane to New York."

And Lord Campbell (family motto: Forget Not) said: "I'm very, very happy that everything is now working out for my wife and myself. We are delighted to be reunited."

## Bowled over

The couple met in New York a year ago when Lord Campbell, younger brother of the Duke of Argyll was on a trip from Fiji visiting his half-sister Lady Jeanne Campbell.

The peer was bowled over by the willowy Georgia — formerly George — Ziadie, and they were married within three days.

When they broke up in January, Lord Colin claimed she had not told him about the sex-change operation until after the wedding.

Lady Campbell went home to Jamaica. And the "let's try again" phone calls began.

Back at the flat Lady Campbell said: "It pleased me that Colin wanted me back, but I needed time to recharge my batteries so to speak.

"Since moving back into Colin's life we have been terribly happy together. It's as if we'd never been apart."
