

ELLIS GLENN.

IMPOSTRESS AGAIN BROUGHT INTO COURT IN WEST VIRGINIA.

The sensational arrest of Ellis Glenn, the woman masquerading as a man, in Paducah a year or two ago on a charge of forgery committed in Parkersburg, West Va., is recalled by dispatches from Parkersburg relative to the trial. Yesterday's telegrams say:

"Ellis Glenn, the alleged male impersonator, charged with forgery, was brought into court this morning. The case depends on whether E. B. Glenn, known as a man, and Ellis Glenn, the woman, are the same persons. She stated that Mrs. Earl Knight, of this city, could state positively that E. B. Glenn can be found at present."
