carried out. An ENO spokesman said yesterday: 'Mr Morris has informed us of his new identity which is being treated as a statement of fact. He will continue his duties as before.' Miss Vivienne, the daughter

of a Cheshire factory fitter, was a staunch advocate of sex equality in male-domi-nated classical music.
