'Madam Stern' of vice racket is convicted by jury as a man

A SADISTIC 'vice queen' was jailed for 18 months vesterday as a man.

Gloria Greaves, who has lived as a woman for over 18 years, was found guilty of living off immoral earnings. Only men can be convicted for the offence.

Later Greaves—whose husband was also on trial-was taken to the women's prison in Holloway, London, N.

Greaves, 50, born Thomas

Robinson, claimed to have had a sex operation 20 years ago.

The defendant was also convicted of running a disorderly house, and was fined £10,000 and ordered to pay costs. The jury had heard that clients at Warwick Way, Westminster, were chained and whipped.

Husband Brian Greaves, 42, was failed for 12 months for living off immoral earnings, which he also denied.

Another defendant, Moira Tan, 46. was jailed for six months

after being found guilty of running a disorderly house.

Police raids on houses owned by Gloria Greaves-known as Madam Stern-were said to have revealed a sex dungeon with stocks, whips and other instruments of 'hard correction'. She claimed to earn up to £1,000 a

Assistant Recorder Mr Roydon Thomas said: 'For the past week, we've had a barrage of filth and degradation arising out of this case.
