

WAS ELLIS GLENN HER TWIN BROTHER

OR HERSELF WAS THE QUESTION
OVER WHICH JURY DISA-
GREED—CASE UP AGAIN.

PARKERSBURG, W. Va., Jan. 31.
—The case of Ellis Glenn, who four years ago had the whole American continent guessing as to whether she was man or woman, who was sent to an Indiana penitentiary as a man and was released because she was found to be woman, was recalled here yesterday when she was called for trial for forgery. Her trial occurred here four years ago. Her defense was that it was not she but her twin brother and the trial developed into a trial as to whether she were a man or woman and whether the alleged twin brother was a man or was herself. The jury disagreed, and her case had been continued from time to time till yesterday, when it developed that the judge before whom she should be tried was assistant prosecutor at the former trial. The case could not be carried to the circuit court for the judge of that court was the prosecutor before. The present prosecutor was her counsel before and the special judge elected to try certain cases was a witness at the former trial. Under the circumstances the trial of the case was continued.
