For Acquittal, Glenn Jury Said to Stand.

Parkersburg, W. Va., July 29.—The jury in the Ellis Glenn case is still out. They were brought into court Monday morning after spending Sunday in custody of the jailer, and immediately went into deliberation. At noon they asked for instructions and at 3 o'clock notified the court of their failure to reach an agreement. The court gave them additional instructions and sent them back to the jury room and at 4:30 they again notified the court that they could not agree. They were then excused until Tuesday. It is understood they stand ten for acquittal and two for conviction.
