The Gender Attitude Reassessment Program (GARP) is a full-day, intensive workshop designed to explore gender diversity within American society. It is particularly appropriate for educators, therapists, social workers, counselors and healthcare professionals. Individuals with a personal interest in gender issues are also welcome to attend.

Through the use of media, face-to-face interaction, role playing, dynamic lecture presentations and printed materials, as well as body movement and focused cognitive processes, the GARP will address concerns relating to gender diversity in the United States.

The workshop agenda includes Gender Role Inventory, the Lenses of Gender, Ethnic and Cultural Diversity and Alternative Gender Forms, the Traditional Props of Gender, and the Tao of Gender, a New Paradigm.

- Become familiar with the concept of Conscious Gender Community (CGC)
- Understand the Jungian concept of anima/animus.
