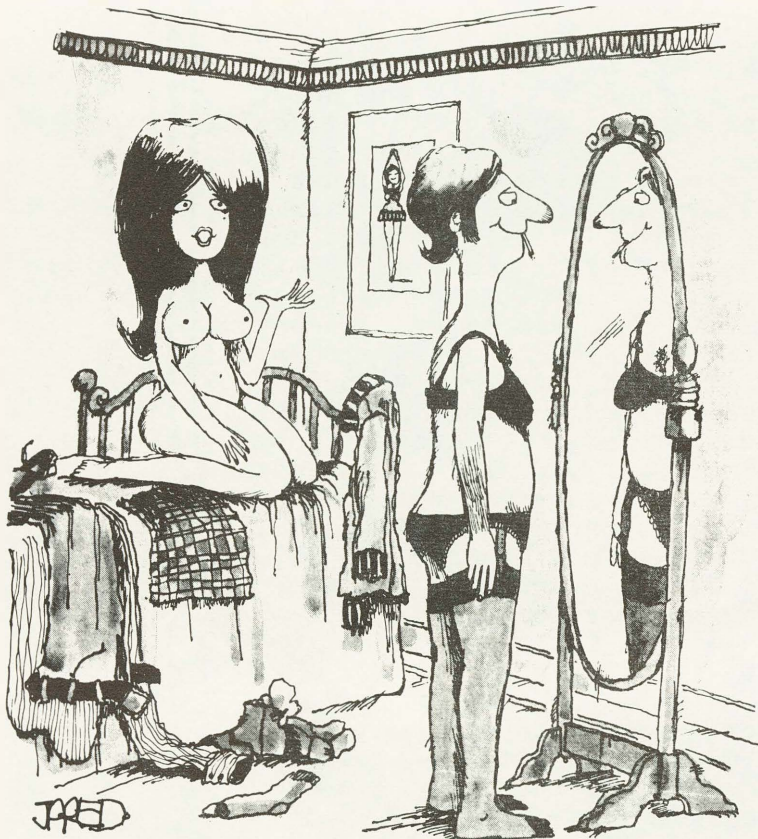

MAN'S CONVICTION OF FEMALE ROLE UPHOLD:

A county criminal court jury upheld a municipal court conviction of Toni Rochelle [redacted], Formerly Richard Anthony [redacted], a transsexual who accused police harassment. [redacted], 26, was found guilty of appearing on a public street Sept. 21 disguised as a member of the opposite sex and was assessed the same \$50 fine levied at a Jan. 11 city court hearing.

The defendant charged after the arrest that police were bent on harassment since only moments before a municipal judge had dismissed an earlier, similar charge against Mayers on a technicality.

Vice officers testified that they arrested [redacted] outside the police station because the [redacted] was violating the city ordinance again.

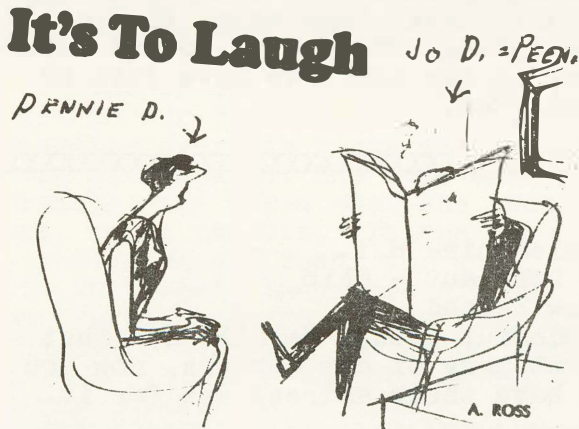
[redacted] was dressed in a feminine pants suit, wore facial makeup, although a sign displayed on the clothing said "My body is male."

The defendant, who also appeared in feminine attire Tuesday, testified that the sign was evidence of an intention to pretend to be a woman.

[redacted] said that in an effort to change sex, [redacted] began living totally as a female" Dec. 1, 1971.

Dr. K. D. Smith, a specialist in reproductive endocrinology at the University of Texas Medical School, testified that [redacted] would be considered a man because of presence of male sex organs and chromosomes but would also be considered a woman because of the presence of female hormones and "psychological orientation."

[redacted] has said the injection of female hormones has gradually brought about sex change. Living as a woman has been a necessary part of the process, [redacted] has said. Lawyer, [redacted] said he probably will appeal the sentence rendered by Judge [redacted] en route to the U.S. Supreme Court. (Taken from THE HOUSTON POST May 23, 1973.)

PASSING IN PUBLIC: Last week a TV visited me to get an opinion on whether or not he could pass in public. He had brought along clothes, wig, etc., and after dressing he posed for me and asked, "Well, how do I look? Do you think I can pass?" I don't know, I answered. "Have you ever practised walking like a woman you age?" "Not really," the TV said. I don't have much time for that." In fact, he had never really looked at a woman to learn how she moved her hands, arms, her legs in everyday life, just being what she is -- a woman. Like to many TV's, each one thinks that just because his clothes are feminine and his make-up simulates a female face, he can pass in public easily.

He is, of course, dead wrong. Passing in public is not easy. To pass you have to know exactly what females of your age look like, how they make-up, how they dress, above all, how they move all parts of their bodies. And this information is not easy to come by! 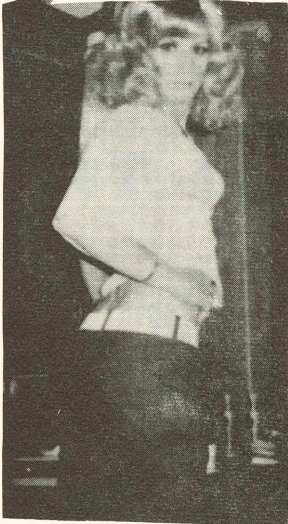
