Crossdressing gay teen Matthew Stickney was suspended Monday, September 9th from school for wearing a dress.

Did you know...

Matthew, who identifies as both gay and crossdressing, explained his attire as an expression of identity and pride.

Matthew was verbally assaulted by other students. Yet the principal claimed that it was *Matthew* who was “creating a disturbance” and suspended *him* from school -- thus punishing him for his own assault while letting the real perpetrators go free.

Did you know...

Trans-phobia is a serious problem. Dozens of people across the US have been killed in the last few years for being “gender-different” like Matthew, including Debbie Forte (MA), Brandon Teena (NE), Chanel Picket (MA), Harold Goldman (NY), Cameron Tanner (CA), Jessy Santiago (NY), Marsha P. Johnson (NY), and Christian Paige (IL).
