In May I was given an honorary luncheon by the male-to-female group here in San Francisco, including a commemorative plaque for my contributions to the gender community. A popular gay bookstore sponsored a book signing party for my new book From Female to Male, a big success! (My publisher informs me that you should be able to purchase From Female to Male at Bookshop Vrolijk, Paleisstraat 135, 1012 ZL Amsterdam Netherlands.) The Ingersoll Gender Center in Seattle, Washington, has finally sent my 3rd edition of Information for the Female-to-Male to the printers and we hope to see it in August. My final life's goals are all being accomplished.

In July I will be in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, for a week visiting my mother, grandmother and brother. I also hope to get together with about 8 FTMs who live in the area for a social meeting.
